

ENVIRONMENTAL CHARGE

The Environmental Charge permits the recovery of environmental remediation expenses incurred as a result of supplying electricity. All residential and general service rates are subject to the Environmental Charge. The following definitions and procedures will be followed in administering the Environmental Charge.

Definitions

Environmental Charge – The amount per kWh by which the applicable rates shall be billed in each month.

Environmental Remediation Costs – Costs incurred as a result of environmental restoration projects.

Procedures

The Environmental Charge shall be applied to each kWh billed to applicable rates. Environmental Charge revenues will offset environmental remediation costs and associated PILOT expense. The Environmental Charge shall be billed until environmental remediation costs are equal to zero. Should the Environmental Charge collect revenues in excess of environmental remediation costs, the difference shall be refunded to the applicable rates.

The Environmental Charge shall be reviewed and revised periodically in accordance with the provisions of this schedule.

Environmental Charge – The current Environmental Charge is \$0.0025/kWh
